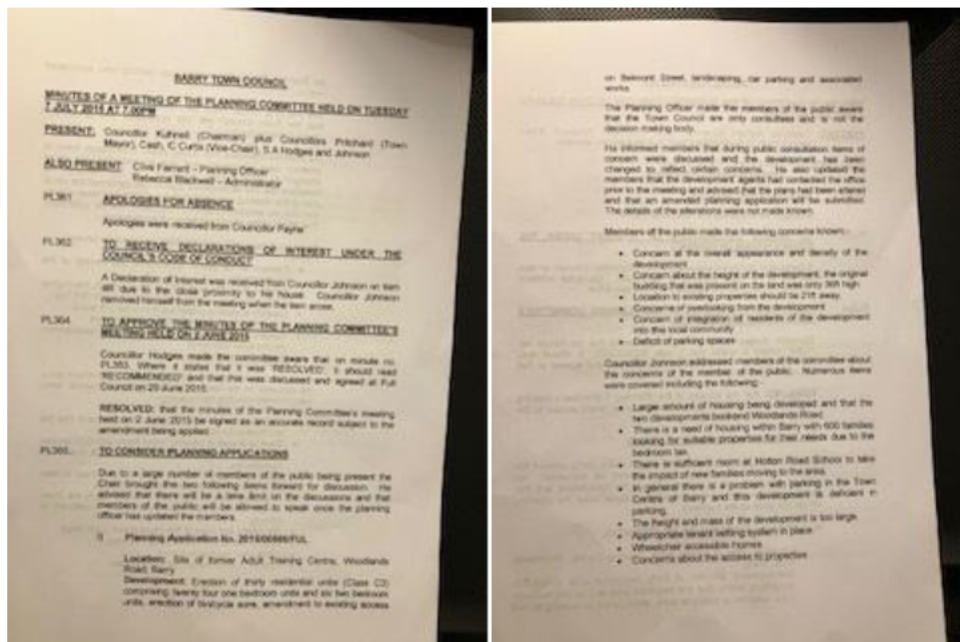

Dear Sirs,

In response to the Vale of Glamorgan Replacement Local Development Plan 2021-2036 Deposit Plan Consultation, I enclose the following:

1. The Public Consultation Representation Form dated 10th March 2026.
2. The supplementary PDF document (Part 2) that sets out my full response, objections and questions in relation to the proposed development at HG1 KS1 Land at North West Barry – Weycock Cross.
3. 2 videos in support of Objections 5 and 7 (as set out in Part 2 of my response) which highlight the current impact of surface water on Millwood, the water courses and the drainage system at Nant Talwg Way.

With regard to the consultation process itself, I wish to provide the following feedback:

- i) Given the volume of documents and reports contained on the Vale website regarding this proposal, and on the basis that many people have full time jobs and family commitments, I consider that the constituents of Barry were afforded insufficient time to properly digest the information.
- ii) The process for submitting the response using the online portal was so complex that I and others had to resort to completing the form online.
- iii) When completing the form, it became apparent after sending the document to myself that it cut off large chunks of text. As a result, it was necessary to set out my response in a separate document (Part 2).

The fact that it was so difficult to participate in the Consultation Process raises various concerns in respect of whether this impacted numerous other people who wished to lodge a response but found themselves unable to do so.
